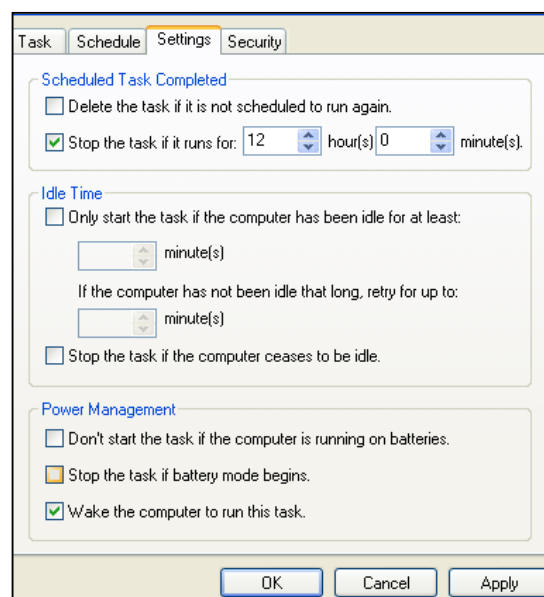


Setting up the Find A Property Uploader

1. Click on 'FindAProperty Uploader' on the downloads page of www.propertypro.co.uk and save it into the PropertyPro folder.
2. Open the PropertyPro folder and create a new folder called FindAProperty
3. Open the FindAProperty folder and create a new folder in there called Data
4. Open the Control Panel from the Start menu
5. Double-click on Scheduled Tasks
6. Double-click on 'Add Scheduled Task'
7. Click Next and then click Browse to find the FindAProperty Uploader. If you go to your PropertyPro folder the file will be called FindAProperty.exe. Click on this file and click OK. Then click Next
8. You will then be asked how frequently you want the task to run. Click Daily and then click Next
9. You will then be asked what time you want the task to run. Enter a time between midnight and the start of your working day and click Next
10. Then enter your password and click Next
11. Put a tick in the box to open the advanced properties and click Finish
12. A new box will open showing the properties of this task.

In the 'Settings' tab the settings should be as follows:



When you have finished entering these settings click Apply and then click OK

Not all property software is the same!

To run the first time:

Right click on Rightmove in the scheduled tasks and click Run. A box will appear asking for the FTP details. Fill this in as follows:



The Branch Ref is provided by FindAProperty

When you have entered these settings click Save

Click on Run in the Start menu. Type in 'Regedit' and click OK

A box will appear with a list of folders down the left-hand side. You need to open the folders in the following order:

- HKey_CurrentUser
- Software
- VB and VBA Program Settings
- PP-FindAPropertyUpload v2.0
- Data

With the Data folder highlighted, right-click on the right-hand side of the screen and click on New > String Value

Name this 'UploadPath' and press the return key

Double-click where it now says UploadPath and a box will appear where you can add the value data. Enter a forward slash (/) into this box and click OK

Close the Registry Editor screen and go back to the box showing the FTP details for the uploader as shown in the box above. You can now click Close

The uploader will now run through. You will not have to enter this data every time. From now on it will run through on its own at the time scheduled.
